Israel's 65th Birthday

Our community gathered to celebrate the 65th birthday of Israel's modern statehood this past week. Yom Haatzmaut or Independence Day began just as Yom HaZikaron, Israel's Memorial Day, ended.

The evening opened with words on the importance of the day by Rabbi Hagay Batzri and a selection of video tributes to those who gave their lives for Israel. Reciting Kaddish, the community joined in prayers for the fallen and for the state of Israel. Recognition and honor was also given to all those who have served in Israel's Defense Forces. And Ronald Einy, our President of the Board addressed those gathered and noted the solemnity of the occasion.

A definite highlight of the evening was a spirited performance by Kahal's David S. Kelly Youth Choir directed by Rabbi Hagay Batzri.

The choir performed a selection from Psalms in honor of the soldiers, and continued with a program of favorite melodies. The songs included Yerushalayim Shel Zahav, Al Kol Ele and others recognizing the beauty of Israel.

The program also included selections such as Od Yavo Shalom and Bashana Haba'a, expressing Israel's eternal hope for peaceful co-existence with its neighbors. And it finished with a medley of familiar tunes such as Hava Nagila, Hevenu Shalom, and David Melekh Yisrael, expressing the Jewish people's irrepressible spirit. Then Hatikva, Israel's national anthem, rang out with the children's pure voices and brought everyone to their feet.

In fact, the audience, inspired by the young vocalists, joined in singing many of the songs, and the crowd's energy built throughout the performance. Following the program, the celebration continued in the Errol Levi Social Hall with falafel and spontaneous Israeli dancing to the music of Lilo Fedida and Tzion Tzioni.

Young and old enjoyed the evening thoroughly. May we merit many more such celebrations and the joy of witnessing Israel's success, development and peace in the years to come.
