SHABBAT MITZVOT at Kahal Joseph Congregation



We now offer for donation the following Mitzvot on Shabbat: **1. Petichat Hechal** The opening of the ark where the Torah scrolls are kept; **2. Carrying of the Sefer Torah & Sefer Haftara**; **3. Hakamat Sefer** The lifting and showing of the Torah; **4. Mashlim*** The seventh aliya to the Torah that recites Kaddish; **5. Maftir*** The last aliya to the Torah including reading of the Haftara (by the clergy unless member reading preapproved). Since we count on your donations to keep our membership fees low, we suggest a minimum donation for mitzvot with the Torah of \$126 (or multiples of \$18 or \$26). *Paid members may call the office to book the Mashlim or Maftir in advance, in memory of a departed relative. You will receive confirmation before Shabbat if you will receive the aliya or if there is a conflict. Members may also reserve other aliyot in advance by calling the office. Non-members interested in reserving aliyot should contact the office for availability at 310.474.0559, 11 am-4 pm, Monday to Thursday. The community appreciates your support.
