Rabbi's Message

Shalom! This week's parasha discusses the laws of purity connected with Tzaraat which was a type of skin affliction. The Torah says this disease was



caused by *lashon hara*, speaking badly or slandering another person. To the person being afflicted, the illness was a sign to mend their ways. For this reason, the person would be sent out of the camp in order to be alone and meditate on their circumstances.

The main purpose of this concept is to teach us the power of our speech. Our words have power. We can choose to have our words be a positive influence. Some examples of positive words are speaking kindly to one another and lifting a person's spirits. Praying to Hashem and singing words of praise. Learning Torah and connecting to Hashem's infinite wisdom.

The holy Chafetz Chaim wrote an entire book on the laws of *lashon hara*. There is a story told about the Chafetz Chaim. He was traveling on a train, and he met a Jew who did not recognize him. The Jew told him, "I'm traveling to visit the Chafetz Chaim in Radin!" The traveler was effusive in his praise. He had heard of the great righteousness and genius of the Chafetz Chaim. The Chafetz Chaim said to him, "Why are you going to him? He is not as great as you think. He is just a simple Jew." The passenger got angry over these words. He disgraced the Chafetz Chaim, cursed him, and ended up hitting him.

Afterward, when he came to visit the Chafetz Chaim in his house, he was astonished to discover that this was the man he had been with on the train...


