Rabbi's Message

Shalom,

This week's parasha begins with Hashem telling Moshe to command the Kohanim about



the laws of purity. "Speak to the *kohanim*, the sons of Aaron," says G-d to Moses in the Parsha of Emor, "and say to them . . ." Unusually, Hashem says "Tell them" twice. The first 'telling' is for Moshe commanding the Kohanim. The second is for the Kohanim to guard their children from impurity as well. The *kohanim* (priests), who perform the service in the Holy Temple on behalf of the people, must adhere to a higher standard of sanctity.

Rashi explains on the second telling "Lehazhir Hagedolim al haktanim," meaning "to warn the elders about the children." Rashi is teaching that this commandment is broader than just the kohanim. This is a commandment for our entire nation that the older generation is responsible for the education and wellbeing of the youth. It constitutes a primary biblical source for the concept of education and also offers insight into the nature of education. The word "Lehazhir," meaning "to warn" can also be translated as "to shine" or "to illuminate."

Seen in this way, the phrase "to warn the elders about the children" also translates as "to illuminate the elders regarding the youngsters." Education is not only an older person teaching a younger person; it is also an illumination for the educator. We are elevated, and we learn, by lifting up the next generation.


