Rabbi's Message

Shalom,

In this week's parasha, Moses continues his final testament to the children of Israel. He

recounts begging Hashem to enter the land of Israel: "let me cross over and see the good land that is on the other side of the Jordan, this good mountain and the Lebanon."

The word Moshe chooses to describe his powerful prayer is "Vaetchanan," or "I beseeched." The numerical value of this word is 515, relating to the number of times Moshe made this request from Hashem. He kept on asking until Hashem told him "enough, do not speak to me regarding this matter any longer. Go up to the top of the hill and lift up your eyes westward and northward and southward and eastward and see with your eyes, for you shall not cross this Jordan [river]."

Hashem had already told Moshe that he wouldn't enter the land. He knew Hashem wasn't changing the decree. Nevertheless, Moshe's prayer still had an effect. Hashem told him 'to see the land.'

This 'seeing' of the land by Moshe elevated the mitzvot and deeds destined to be fulfilled by the nation when in the land of Israel in the future. Moshe's intention was to empower and uplift the nation. Even though he wouldn't be with them in the holy land, he still wanted to strengthen the nation in any way possible.
