This week's parasaha, Nitzavim, begins with these powerful



words, "You are all standing this day before the Lord, your God. The leaders of your tribes, your elders and your officers, every man of Israel; your young children, women, and your convert who is within your camp; both your woodcutters and your water drawers, that you may enter the covenant of the Lord, your God, and His oath, which the Lord, your God, is making with you this day, in order to establish you this day as His people, and that He will be your God, as He spoke to you, and as He swore to your forefathers to Abraham, to Isaac, and to Jacob. But not only with you am I making this covenant and this oath, but with those standing here with us today before the Lord, our God, and [also] with those who are not here with us, this

This was the last day of Moshe's life on this earth. For this reason, he gathered all of the children of Israel to hear his final testimony. The verse describes ten types of people in our nation,




