Rabbi's Message

Shalom, we begin reading the Torah anew this week. Genesis, also known as Beresheet, relates the classic story of creation which



embodies many of the struggles we face in our lives. Nachmanides states in his commentary to the Torah that the story of creation is very spiritual and that there is no real way of explaining it in our physical realm or level of understanding.

Nevertheless, on a simpler level there are still many lessons to learn from this Parasha. For example, there is the moment when Hashem told Adam not to eat the fruit from the Tree of Knowledge. When Adam relayed this information to Eve, he added to the commandment, and said that Hashem had forbidden touching the tree as well as eating its fruit. He thought this extra caution would help Eve. Instead it made the situation worse. When she saw that nothing occurred when she touched the tree, she became confused which then led to the eating of the fruit. We should be careful in our approach to the Torah and in how we relay its teachings to others. We must not try to outsmart Hashem.

After the sin, Adam realized his nakedness and felt his shame so he tried to hide from Hashem. Hashem asked, "Where are you?" This conversation between Hashem and Adam is quite stirring. On a simple level Hashem was trying to give Adam time to compose himself and be able to enter a conversation with Hashem. On a deeper level Hashem was saying, "Where are you Adam? Where have you fallen to?"

Did Adam see his fault and admit his guilt?
