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Rabbi's Message

Shalom u'vracha,

What a year it has been! It is fitting we read Parashat Vayechi (referring to when Jacob lived in Egypt), which



concludes the book of Genesis. In this Torah portion, Jacob recounts his final testimony and blessings to his sons and the tribes of Israel. There are deep, mystical meanings in the story that are pertinent to our time.

Jacob lived a difficult life and went through many challenging ordeals. His fight with Eisav. His dealings with Lavan, his father-in-law. The early passing of Rachel. And finally, what he believed was the loss of Yosef for many years. This last event brought him into a state of deep mourning and sadness.

The Torah communicates that Hashem created a kindness in our natural disposition related to mourning. The pain of someone's passing begins to become less intense after the first year of mourning. But, since Yosef hadn't truly passed away, Jacob's pain remained at the same intense level for all 22 years that Yosef was missing. During this entire period, the Shechinah, Hashem's divine presence, left Jacob during his overwhelming grief. Joy is prerequisite to sensing and experiencing the divine presence.

When he was reunited with Yosef in Egypt, the Shechinah also reunited with Jacob. This is hinted at in the verse "and he saw the wagons that Joseph had sent to carry him, and the spirit of their father Jacob was revived." When commenting on Jacob's life pattern, going through difficulties then attaining tranquility at the end, the Torah states: 'the righteous suffer in the beginning while enjoying at the end, while the opposite is the case with the wicked.'

The history of our nation is foretold in the lives of our forefathers...
