Dear Member,

We are preparing to open for Shabbat Morning Services on Saturday, March 6th 2021 from 9 am to 11 am in the morning, in accordance with the applicable CDC Guidelines.

How to Attend?

- **Pre-register online**, one form per person (click button above).
- **Arrive early** on Shabbat morning--Pre-registered members will be admitted on Shabbat morning on a first-come, first-served basis.
- **Bring valid ID.** No admittance without your ID.

Who can attend?

- **Members Only**
 - Members who are adults
 - Members' children who are teenagers between 13 and 18 years old and who are accompanied by the adult member
 - Members who are not otherwise at risk

Who should not attend?

- Those over the age of 65 or in a high risk group (diabetics, those with high blood pressure, heart or lung disease, etc.) are encouraged to

consult with their physician before attending the services.

Who cannot attend?

- **Non Members**
- Children under the age of 13
- Anyone who has symptoms that may be from COVID-19
- Anyone who has tested positive for COVID-19 within 14 days of the date of attendance
- Anyone who may have been exposed to COVID-19 within 14 days of the date of attendance
- Anyone who lives with a person who may have been exposed to Covid-19 within 14 days of the date of attendance
- Anyone feeling sick for any reason

COVID-19 symptoms as described by the CDC include: cough, shortness of breath or difficulty breathing, fever, chills, muscle pain, sore throat, loss of taste or loss of smell.

Conditions of attending:

- Pre-register by filling out the form using the link below.
- Wear a **face mask** at all times in and around Kahal Joseph's synagogue building.
- **Bring valid ID.** No one will be admitted to the synagogue without proof of ID.
- Bring your own kippah, siddur, chumash, tallit and tefillin to the synagogue. **None will be provided.**
- Agree to a temperature check and to sanitize your hands before entering building.
- Anyone who has a temperature or who shows symptoms of illness will not be allowed to enter the building.
- You must maintain physical distancing of 6 feet or more from other people at all times while in the synagogue building.
- You must follow all instructions given by Kahal Joseph's clergy, staff, and security personnel.
- Congregating and socializing are not allowed before or after services.
- Chanting during the prayers and touching the Torah will not be allowed.
- You must stay in or at your seat while in the sanctuary.
- You must not approach the Tebah or touch the Torah while in the synagogue.
