# Rabbi's Message

Shalom U'vracha,

This week's Parasha Vayikra picks up after the inauguration of the



tabernacle. The Zohar comments: "Ask for yourself a sign from the Lord, your God: ask it either in the depths or in the heights above."

When looking at the earlier and later generations (of our nation), we notice a difference between them. The earlier generations were able to look into the higher spiritual wisdom of the Torah (as they were more knowledgeable in this matter). This enabled them to form words as they were given to Moses at Mount Sinai. Every letter transmitted to Moshe at Sinai flew with angels and powerful revelations.

These words of the Torah had great power and the ability to impact our reality, creating change in this world. Even the sinners in our nation knew this wisdom. Indeed, all the nation knew the abundant secrets and mysteries found in the letters of the Torah. This enlightenment enabled us to affect physical creation in powerful ways. This power connects to the Hebrew word 'ot' for 'a letter.' The same word can also mean 'a sign.'

The Zohar implies that generating these signs and wonders is a simple, even ordinary, feat when one knows the method of the Torah to accomplish this. Although the majority of us may no longer know this mystical power consciously, this doesn't mean we aren't able to tap into this amazing power.

All of the Torah is connected to the 'Tree of Life,' while physical objects of creation are connected with the 'Tree of Knowledge.' By learning Torah and

## Condolences to the Family and Friends of Vera Levi, z"l

With great sorrow we send our deepest condolences to the family and friends of Vera Levi, z"l, Yael bat Eugene, who passed away on Tuesday, March 16, 2021, the 3rd of Nisan, at 101 years old. Vera is the wife of Kahal Joseph's beloved and gifted founder, Rabbi Elias Levi, z"l, and the mother of our dear member, Judy Lurie.

Vera was born on June 4, 1919 in Breslau, Germany, to Margot and Eugene Altmann. Her path out of Germany was as a youth aliyah, which brought her to Kibbutz Ein Harod. She was 16 years old, her formal education had come to an end, and she didn't know if she would ever see her family again. She would spend a decade in Israel, and those difficult years were the ones that she would later acknowledge as forging her character and her path in life.

Vera discovered the beauty of Judaism and her fervent love for Eretz Yisrael on the kibbutz. Following two years at Ein Harod, she remained in what was then the British Mandate of Palestine. Because of her English language skills, she was signed by the Royal Air Force (RAF) to work in Ismailia, Egypt, as a member of the Women's Auxiliary Air Force (WAAF) tracking and plotting "friend or foe" aircraft.

When she was reunited with her parents and brother in San Francisco, she met and married the founding rabbi of our synagogue, Elias Levi, z"I, and became our dear rabbanit whom so many have cherished through the decades, turning to her for guidance, wisdom, and--always--cheer. A "Sephardi at heart," she fell in love with the Iraqi traditions and the wisdom of traditional Judaism. She was the first to say that while "Elias and I couldn't have come from more different worlds"--when they found each other, she was home.

She is survived by her children Sylvia, Ruth, Judith, Ariel; her grandchildren; her great-grandchildren; extended family and friends.

Funeral services will took place on Friday, March 19th. Due to Covid, the family will be observing a private shiva. Our thoughts and prayers go out to Vera's loved ones. May they be comforted together with all the mourners of Tsion. *Min hashamayim tenuhamu*.
