The Midrash, a part of the Torah that dates back

thousands of years and was compiled into books approximately 1600 years ago, makes a powerful statement: "In the future to come, the land of Israel will spread across the earth."

There are numerous explanations for this. Whenever we are exiled to a certain part of the earth, this has to with the divine mystical concept of refining the sparks of energy found in that place that have been waiting to be elevated.

By our service of fulfilling mitzvot, learning the Torah, and living good Jewish lives, we spread holiness in all the places we live. Rabbi Nachman of Breslov states that Jewish communities increase the holiness in the places they live in. This is something that can be tangibly felt.

When we conclude our mission in a place, we may not know that we are done. Interestingly enough, it seems that the nations of these lands seem to sense when we have 'finished our jobs' throughout history across the earth. By forcing Israel out of their lands, they unintentionally help fulfill Hashem's divine intention of spreading Israel across


