Rabbi's Message

Shalom U'vracha,

Last week we read about the offerings of the princes on the day of the tabernacle's

inauguration. Aharon was not commanded to join the princes and the tribe of Levi was not represented.

Aharon witnessed all of their offerings and was disheartened, 'For when Aharon saw the dedication offerings of the chieftains, he felt distressed over not joining them in this dedication--neither he nor his tribe. So God said to him, "By your life, yours is greater than theirs, for you will light and prepare the lamps [of the Menorah]."

The lighting of the Menorah was a main function of the Temple. The significance of this powerful light was manifested on many levels. Simply, the light shone and made an impact on the physical and spiritual worlds. Aharon's lighting of the Menorah inspired the lighting of a higher spiritual menorah which connects to the source of our souls and increases the flow in Hashem's communication with us.

There are seven branches on the Temple's

Menorah. These correspond to the seven days of creation and to the seven spheres of creation, each a source of the unique service to Hashem. The seven spheres relate to different emotive manners of connection to Hashem among the souls in Israel. Some people are spiritually fulfilled and inspired through love and adoration of Hashem. Others gravitate towards awe and fear of Hashem, and seek a serious relationship. Torah is considered the middle path.


