Rabbi's Message

Shalom U'vracha,

We are coming to the 9th of Av. This year Tisha B'Av falls on Sunday, July 18th. The

Zohar explains that during the Three Weeks between the 17th of Tamuz and the 9th of Av, Hashem mourns the destruction of the Temple—the Bet HaMikdash and our exile.

Hashem's mourning is compared to that of a King extremely angered and hurt by His children's wayward behavior. Instead of taking His anger out on the children, the King destroys His palace, our Temple. The children are sent away. In His concern for them, He sends His wife, the queen, to watch over them.

Hashem, our Father, mourns His separation from us. So, too, do we, His children, mourn in exile; we feel our pain and the pain of the King.

During the Three Weeks, Hashem expresses His pain. He mourns the exile of the Shechinah (the divine, feminine presence of Hashem that gives life to the world) and of Israel. As we mourn with Hashem, this challenging time for our nation offers us a lesson. We must have strong resolve and focus

clearly in our lives. Our focus helps us identify and address matters that need attention in our lives.

In this week's parasha, Devarim, Moshe begins his final testimony to the nation during the last 37 days of his life. In Beresheet/Genesis, Shemot/Exodus, Vayikra/Leviticus, and Bamidbar/Numbers—the first four books of the Torah, Hashem directly gives the Torah's laws to Moshe. Beyond Moshe's understanding of what is being transcribed, he has little, if any, influence or intellectual involvement in the message. Moshe is purely a conduit for Hashem's message.

In the book of 'Devarim', however, Moshe begins involving his intellect in the authorship of the words. He gives his take on the Torah...
