Rabbi's Message

Shalom U'vracha,

We read the story of Noah and the flood in this week's Parasha. There is an age-old debate of the

level of Noah's level of righteousness. There are many levels when speaking of Tzadikim- righteous people.

The midrash tells us that when Noah exited the boat and saw the world destroyed he cried before Hashem, 'How could you do this?'

Hashem retorted, "Why didn't you pray for them? Why didn't you try to help them repent?"

Noah was afraid of his generation since they were wicked. For this reason, he hid away from them, choosing not to rebuke them. He feared for his safety.

Indeed there were other tzadikim; together with Noah, there were nine of them. Ten people are a prerequisite for drawing down the shechinah, the divine presence of Hashem. For this reason, having a minyan (a quorum of ten) is so important for our communal prayers. If Noah, along with the 8 other tzadikim, had prayed for Hashem to save the world, the Shechinah would have joined with them to help them reach the number ten.

If Noah would have changed his approach, he actually would have been able to save the world from the horrible decree. Unfortunately, he didn't. He followed his fears and doubts, and this led to the unfortunate turn of events.

This is why the Torah says "Noah walked with Elokim." He needed Hashem's help to stay at his level, and he didn't really grow.
