Rabbi's Message

This week's parasha continues the story of Avraham and Sarah. We see the extent of Avraham's desire to reach others and

bestow kindness upon them. He is visited by Hashem three days after his circumcision. This is the most painful time after circumcision, and Hashem wanted to bring healing to Avraham. Yet, when Avraham sees guests (who were really angels), he asks Hashem to wait so he can invite them in. His desire to teach and bring light to the world superseded his pain.

Avraham used his skills as a host to teach the masses about Hashem and spirituality. This story teaches us that hosting guests is as great as receiving the divine presence of Hashem. The Zohar explains that Avraham was helping people become purified physically and spiritually. Avraham is connected to the spiritual aspect of water, which is a fundamental part of purification.

As we see in this story, the first thing

At the time, the world was steeped in idol worship. This brought a great spiritual impurity upon those who were involved in this type of worship.

For this reason, the first thing Avraham would do with those he brought closer to Hashem was purify them with water.



DINAH'S LATKES – INDIAN STYLE

from <u>Made with Love From Kitty's Kitchen</u> A NEW Cookbook! *Ordering information below*

INGREDIENTS

2 cups coarsely grated potatoes
(old potatoes have more starch)
1 small onion, finely grated
¼ cup Matzo Meal
2 eggs, lightly beaten
½ tsp minced garlic
½ tsp turmeric
1 tsp each salt and pepper
2 sprigs spring onions, finely chopped*
¼ cup coriander (cilantro), freshly chopped
* 2 chillies, deseeded and finely chopped*



3 tbs canola or vegetable oil – you may require to add more oil through the frying process

METHOD

- 1. Place grated potatoes in a large bowl covered with water and allow to soak for 20 minutes.
- 2. Drain potatoes and squeeze out all the moisture.
- 3. Place in a large bowl, add all other ingredients except the oil and mix together.
- 4. Heat oil in a medium sized frypan. Spoon in 2 tbs of the mixture and flatten to resemble an oval disc. Fry

until crispy and light brown then flip over and cook the other side. Remove and drain on absorbent paper.

Continue until mixture is finished. 5. Serve warm / hot.

HINTS/NOTES For basic Latkes remove the last 3 ingredients with *. MAKES approximately 12
