Rabbi's Message

Shalom Uvracha,

This week's parasha marks the passing of our Matriarch Sarah. This begs a simple question:

why is the parasha called "the life of Sarah"? Wouldn't "the passing of Sarah" be a more fitting name?

We saw in last week's parasha, through the incident when Sarah told Avraham to expel Hagar and Yishmael from their home, that Sarah had a bit more of the attribute of "Justice" than Abraham. This enabled her to make the difficult decisions.

The events of this week's parasha reveal her influence even after her passing. In seeking a wife for his son Isaac, Abraham knew that the woman needed to be special person with high moral character, integrity and strength, so he decided to look for her amid his extended family. He appointed Eliezer to seek out and find such a woman among them.

Eliezer created a test to determine who would offer the right match: she had to have kindness, a trait that Sarah exemplified. In fact, Rebecca displayed this kindness to Eliezer immediately after meeting him. departure with Eliezer to meet Isaac, Rebecca displayed the strength of Sarah. Rebecca went against her family's wishes and decided to return with Eliezer immediately.

Rebecca is called "a rose amongst the thorn". Even though she grew up among evil people, she wasn't influenced by their behavior and remained steadfast in her faith. This was the same strength Sarah showed on numerous occasions.

The midrash states, "Three miraculous phenomena occurred in the tent during Sarah's lifetime. Her candle remained lit from one Friday to the next. The dough was blessed and always sufficed for the family and guests. And, a Divine cloud 'was attached' to the tent. These miracles ceased to occur when Sarah passed. When Isaac married Rebecca and brought her into Sarah's tent, they returned immediately." This midrash highlights the inherent holiness of both our matriarchs.


