Rabbi's Message



Rabbi Natan Halevy

Shalom ubracha,

This week's parasha tells us about the struggles of Isaac and Rebecca in having children. They had

to wait a very long time until she became pregnant. They both prayed intensely for children. This teaches us that Hashem desires the prayers of the righteous. For this reason, Hashem withholds blessings from them in order for them to pray more.

The word in Hebrew to describe their praying is an unusual term not generally found in the Torah. It indicates an abundance of prayers. The Zohar comments that this word is close to the word which means to dig. This teaches that Isaac was literally reaching higher and deeper levels of G-dliness with his prayers.

Rebecca and Isaac not only offered abundant prayers, they also sought deep communication with Hashem in which they reached higher and higher levels of connection with Hashem. So should we. We are faced with an interesting dichotomy that Hashem has created. On one side, Hashem has given us free choice and created within us the potential to develop into self-sufficient beings. The

true measure of our responsibility is our ability to respond to various situations. True leaders often possess strong abilities, deep analysis, and sharp judgment. They have the ability to make challenging decisions and resolve difficult situations, to give advice and lead people and communities.

The greatest thing we can do is foster our leadership skills and choose direction in our own lives. We thereby increase our self-control and our influence on those around us; we are able to display a strong example and offer direction to those closest to us. At the same time, we must develop a strong relationship and reliance on Hashem.




