Rabbi's Message

Shalom Uvracha,

We reach the crescendo of the tale of Yosef and his brothers in this week's parasha. Yosef had demanded that his

brothers bring Benjamin with them when they returned for more food. He then incriminated Benjamin by having a goblet placed in his bag, and told the brothers that Benjamin was to be punished for this crime by becoming his slave.

Judah had made a guarantee to Jacob about Benjamin's safety. Therefore Judah took the lead in this situation as well. Things became heated between Yosef and Judah. Judah was being tested in the exact same manner as when he had advised his brothers to sell Yosef. However, in this instance Judah is willing to risk his life for Benjamin's wellbeing, stating "So now, please let your servant stay instead of the boy as a slave to my lord, and may the boy go up with his brothers. For how will I go up to my father if the boy is not with me? Let me not see the misery that will befall my father!"

Judah had learned from his prior mistakes. He was willing to become a slave in order not to repeat

them. At that point, Yosef was unable to hold back any longer and revealed himself to his brothers. It was an emotional reunion that took place, as he said: "I am Joseph. Is my father still alive? I am your brother Joseph, whom you sold into Egypt. But now do not be sad, and let it not trouble you that you sold me here, for it was to preserve life that God sent me before you. For already two years of famine [have passed] in the midst of the land, and [for] another five years, there will be neither plowing nor harvest. And God sent me before you to make for you a remnant in the land, and to preserve [it] for you for a great deliverance."


