Rabbi's Message

Shalom U'vracha,

This week's parasha continues the description of the sanctuary, or *mishkan*, in the desert.

Moshe wanted to bring valuable donations as well, but Hashem told him not to bother because Moshe had reached a higher level by influencing the nation who brought their donations. This teaches us that someone who influences others to do good is very precious to Hashem.

Interestingly, Moshe's name isn't mentioned in the entire portion of *Tetzaveh*. When the nation had sinned with the golden calf, Moshe pleaded with Hashem to forgive them. He said if Hashem didn't forgive Bne Yisrael, then 'Erase me from this book [the Torah] which you have written.' Hashem didn't do that. However, as a sign that when a great and righteous person says something it always has an effect, Moshe's name wasn't mentioned in one Torah portion, *Tetzaveh*, which we read this week.

Moshe's words and actions showed the great love, selflessness and devotion he had for the people. He wanted no greatness for himself and was completely dedicated to the nation. Many leaders of nations in our time would do well to learn from

this example.

The parasha discusses many beautiful components of the garments worn by the Kohen Gadol, the high priest. "The holy garments that are Aaron's shall be for his sons after him, to be exalted through them and invested with full authority through them."
