types of sacrifices brought in the Temple. The sacrifice named the Olah referred to the elevated offering. The Olah was a sacrifice that was completely burned before Hashem; only the skin of the animal was given as a gift to the Cohen.

The elevation of the Olah offering was inherently connected to the nation of Israel. In the Song of Songs, *Shir Hashirim*, King Solomon sings: "Who is this beautiful one ascending from the desert?" Ascending in Hebrew has the same root as the word 'Olah'. The 'ascension from the desert' alludes to our nation coming out of Egypt. Why?

Our nation had descended to a very low spiritual level in Egypt. The plagues that led to our redemption from Egypt initiated a process of spiritual elevation. That process fully began when we left Egypt. At that moment, we embarked on a process of spiritual elevation on a national level. This was also the main purpose of our path during the 40 years spent in the desert.
