Rabbi's Message

Shalom Uvracha,

This week's parasha, Metsora, continues to discuss several topics from last week's Torah portion. We have

already learned that all animals brought as sacrifices must be kosher and non-injured. The fact that the Torah emphasizes these details teaches us another lesson.

As we saw last week, slandering others results in negative consequences. Negative gossip is considered a form impure speech. The discussion of purity in birds offered as sacrifices hints, once again, that a person must work on purifying their speech.

Let's take a moment to consider. Gossip is usually shared in an energetic and enthusiastic manner. Similarly, birds brought as offerings must be healthy and full of vitality. In this condition, most birds chirp just like the person who gossips. So, the person who gossips brings birds as an offering to the cohanim, the priests, to atone for engaging in negative speech.

When the Torah discusses laws that are above our understanding it uses the word 'Chukat' which means a 'decree' about

something. However, in this week's parasha the Torah calls the process of atoning for negative speech the 'Torat', the 'law' about the process, because the stages in the process of atonement teach us practical lessons, lessons which may be understood with the rational mind.

King Solomon states: "With the fruit of his mouth does a man's stomach become sated; with the produce of his lips he is sated."

King Solomon uses the phrases "fruit of his mouth" and "produce of his lips" to suggest the results of a person's words. He emphasizes the power of speech. As the words we speak are repeated, they grow—here, creating a positive harvest. However if misused, our words may produce negative, but similarly bountiful, results.


