# Rabbi Natan Halevy

Shalom U'vracha,

This week's parasha begins, "If you follow My statutes, observe My commandments and perform them, I will give your rains in

their time, the Land will yield its produce, and the tree of the field will give forth its fruit."

Rain is the lifeblood of the world; without it humankind can't live. When we are spiritually attuned, we are able to draw down positive energy and affect the world through our prayers. Some say that this positive energy affects everything in the world, including the cycles of nature, of which we are a part.

In some ways, we easily see the energy of human beings affecting the world, for example as we influence and affect the environment through our choices, our industry, our actions. In other ways, our spiritual energy continually influences the flow of life through the cycles of nature, influencing phenomena such as the rain that falls.

Rain sustains life, helping to create food for all beings through plants. All produce will increase and be blessed by it, just as Hashem said, "and the Land shall yield her produce, and the trees of the field shall yield their fruit." Thus, the blessing in our parasha, the blessing for the appropriate rains in their seasons, is the greatest of all blessings. Therefore it is given first place, and opens the parasha.

As the heavens will respond to the earth with rains in their seasons, so too the earth shall respond with its "produce", which includes not only vegetation, but all moving creatures — cattle, beasts, creeping things and fowl, as well as fish. The statement that "the land' shall yield her produce" includes the whole of the lower sphere, everything under the moon and within its sphere on earth. In other words, all things created in the lower spheres are "the produce of the earth."

Moreover, when the rains come in their proper season, the air is pure and good; the springs and rivers are good and clear. Thus, the rain is a prime cause of physical health.
