Rabbi's Message

Shalom U'vracha,

This week's parasha discusses how Hashem commanded Moshe to organize soldiers and fight against the nation of Midian: "Take revenge

for the children of Israel against the Midianites." There was a spiritual element inherent in this battle.

Midian as a nation represents the negative energy of baseless hatred. This is the impulse to strongly dislike, or even hate, another person or another people for no reason whatsoever. The name 'Midian' is connected to the Hebrew word for judgement, "din".

Judging others excessively or unfairly can lead to this type of senseless hatred—for example, through racism or antisemitism. The Israelites' war against Midian weakened this energy in the world, but did not entirely eliminate it. While this type of energy may seem harmless at first, in the end it may become quite powerful and destructive.

To understand the power of senseless hatred, simply consider the forces that destroyed the First Temple and Second Temple in Jerusalem. We are told that the First Temple was destroyed because of bloodshed, immoral relations and idol worship in Israel. The nation was able to rectify the negativity of these sins within 70 years of the Babylonian exile.
