We read this powerful verse frequently when traveling or at other times when we feel vulnerable: "For Hashem will command his angels to protect you." The verse was

first written in relation to Jacob; it is part of this week's parasha. During Jacob's sojourns, HaShem always sent angels to protect and help him.

As Jacob returns to the holy land, the Shechinah, Hashem's divine presence, welcomes him home. Because he left and successfully returned to the place that would become the land of Israel, Jacob embodies the energy of completion. He is also the father whose offspring became the twelve tribes of Israel.

HaShem blessed Jacob that his offspring would spread forth in all directions. After their exodus from Egypt, the tribes camped in the desert. The tribes divided into four groups, with three tribes in each group. The four groups were located on the four sides of the *Mishkan* or Tabernacle. This is one reason that the tribes are associated with the four directions of east, west, north and south. Symbolically, spreading in the four directions enables us, as a nation, to realize a fundamental aspect of our existence: bringing Hashem's blessing to the world around us throughout our lives.
